

DAILY GOSPEL READINGS THIS WEEK

"Your light must shine before others." — Matthew 5:16

"You are the salt of the earth," Jesus says. "You are the light of the world." In these two phrases, Jesus describes the identity and mission of his followers. "Your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father." This is our life and call. Salt preserves, seasons and changes. Light enables vision, movement and acts. It frees us. Isaiah tells us, "Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own. Then your light shall break forth like the dawn." The prophet describes tangible love. This is what it means to be light for people in darkness and salt for those who need a taste of hope.

As people of God we are called to live differently. Our life in Christ requires us to act with compassion, mercy and justice. Psalm 112 tells us, "The just man [woman] is a light in darkness to the upright." May our good deeds reveal and glorify our heavenly Father!

Project Update: Maintaining God's House

The set of building plans submitted to Monterey County in December are under review by six separate county departments. Our architect is communicating regularly with each department to ensure good communication and a quick response to any questions. We are still hoping to receive approval this spring.

Our Capital Campaign continues to progress with 100 pledges totaling \$638,755 through mid-January, and total donations (pledge and nonpledge) totaling \$692,031. 
