"Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes' and your 'No' mean 'No.'—Matthew 5:37

We are all given free will to choose. This is very clear in our reading from Sirach. He tells us, "If you choose you can keep the commandments, they will save you; if you trust in God, you too shall live." We are urged to choose life! God's wisdom guides us to choose life over death, good over evil. Paul, too, in his first letter to the Corinthians, speaks to us of the wisdom of God revealed in the crucified Lord. Isaiah and Jeremiah are quoted in the beautiful passage, "What eye has not seen, and ear has not heard, and what has not entered the human heart, what God has prepared for those who love him, this God has revealed to us through the Spirit."

Psalm 119 joyfully proclaims, "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!" The words call us as disciples to live and act according to God's wisdom and God's ways so to "enter the kingdom of God," as Jesus urges us. This means choosing life and love. "Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No.' Anything more is from the evil one."

Project Update: Maintaining God's House

The set of building plans submitted to Monterey County in December are under review by six separate county departments. Our architect is communicating regularly with each department to ensure good communication and a quick response to any questions. We are still hoping to receive approval this spring.

Our Capital Campaign continues to progress with 100 pledges totaling \$638,755 through the second week of February, and total donations (pledge and non-pledge) totaling \$692,031. 
