
# *Fírst Sunday of Lent* March 1, 2020



DAILY GOSPEL READINGS THIS WEEK

Monday: Matt 25:31-46 Tuesday: Mark 6:7-15 Wed.: Luke 11:29-32 Thursday: Matt 7:7-12 Friday: Matt 5:20-26 First Reading: Genesis 2:7-9, 3:1-7; Ps. 103:1-4, 8, 10, 12-13; Second Reading: Romans 5:12-19; Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11

"The Lord, your God, shall you worship and him alone shall you serve." —Matthew 4:10

Temptation can be very powerful. Centering our lives on ourselves, rather than the needs of others, can often get in the way of our faithfulness to God's Kingdom and the solidarity that we are called to live and serve. This first Sunday of Lent reminds us of the importance of acknowledging the temptations and sin that often control our lives and our faithfulness to God.

Satan notices Jesus fasting 40 days and 40 nights. In Jesus' weakened state, Satan attempts to control the Lord. Evil, however, has no power over Jesus. Each of Satan's attempts fail. He remains faithful to his mission and the Father's will. Prayer, his intimate relationship with the Father, is Jesus' strength—as is true for us, also. Lent offers us a sacred time for prayer and communion with Jesus so to imitate his faithfulness and love. This is especially true in our moments of weakness. Moments when Jesus makes it very clear, "The Lord, your God, shall you worship and him alone shall you serve."

#### Project Update: Maintaining God's House

The set of building plans submitted to Monterey County in December are under review by six separate county departments. Our architect is communicating regularly with each department to ensure good communication and a quick response to any questions. We are still hoping to receive approval this spring.




