“Stay with us.” —Luke 24:29

Pope Francis tells us, “The pandemic reminds us there are no differences or borders between those who suffer. We are all frail, all equal, all precious. May we be profoundly shaken: Now is the time to eliminate inequalities and heal the injustice undermining the health of the entire human family!” The words of Francis urge us to be one with our human family as we suffer together the pain and sadness of COVID-19.

The disciples on their way home to Emmaus fail to recognize Jesus in the stranger walking alongside them. Their pain, however, serves to welcome the stranger into their lives. As they sit down at table together, “he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight.”

We, too, are invited to open our hearts to the risen Jesus and recognize him in the Eucharist and in the sorrow and suffering of others. Let us invite our Lord to “stay with us” and change our sadness into immense joy this Easter!

Project Update: Maintaining God’s House - 4/26

This past week the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District issued a water use permit for our project. This was the last requirement before Monterey County would issue our building permit. We are optimistic that a permit will be in hand shortly, though construction cannot begin until the county stay-at-home order is modified or lifted. Progress with our architect and prospective contractor continues to be made in evaluating approaches to match likely project costs to funding. A more complete update on both the Capital Campaign and the building project will be included with next Sunday’s bulletin

Our Capital Campaign continues with 102 pledges and donations totaling \$697,261. We are grateful for all of you who are participating in the campaign.

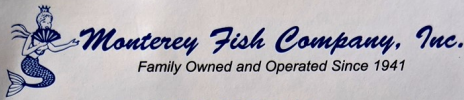
