# "Beside restful waters he leads me; he refreshes my soul." Ps. 23

As followers of Jesus, hearing our Lord's voice is always comforting. It truly refreshes our soul. In the midst of the pandemic and other challenges that come our way, we know that we are safe and not alone. Jesus, as John tells us, is not only our shepherd, but also the gate that protects us. "I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture...I came so that you might have life and have it more abundantly." Jesus is not only the Good Shepherd leading us to the Father, he is also the gate through which we pass to encounter the Father's eternal love.

Peter reminds us that Christ suffered for us, leaving us an example to follow. He shows us the way to endure suffering with grace. For Jesus is "the shepherd and guardian of your souls." The healing heart of our Shepherd accompanies us with boundless mercy, love and protection. "I fear no evil; for you are at my side with your rod and your staff that give me courage."

# Project Update: Maintaining God's House - 4/26

This past week the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District issued a water use permit for our project. This was the last requirement before Monterey County would issue our building permit. We are optimistic that a permit will be in hand shortly, though construction cannot begin until the county stay-at-home order is modified or lifted. Progress with our architect and prospective contractor continues to be made in evaluating approaches to match likely project costs to funding. A more complete update on both the Capital Campaign and the building project will be included with next Sunday's bulletin

Our Capital Campaign continues with 102 pledges and donations totaling \$697,261. We are grateful for all of you who are participating in the campaign.


