

GOSPEL READINGS FOR THE WEEK

"Live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you." -2 Corinthians 13:11

This Most Holy Trinity Sunday reminds us that we have reason to *rejoice* in God's love. Our Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier unites us in a loving relationship with one another and all creation. As one family, we are created in God's image and likeness. God, as Exodus tells us, cries out to Moses—and us—proclaiming God's very being: "The Lord, the Lord, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity."

We are reminded this Sunday that the Most Holy Trinity unites us in the beautiful gift of our diversity. As baptized, we are to live as a beloved family, children of God, servants of the sacredness of every life. We pray today for one another and for the ability to change our ways and bring healing and justice to our nation. May our souls guide us to witness and live our faith. We cannot *rejoice* in God's love if we fail to recognize our God in every race and tongue. As Jesus tells us in his Beatitudes (Matt. 5:1-12): Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for justice...Blessed are the peacemakers..."

Pope Francis' Message on Social Unrest

"Dear brothers and sisters in the United States, I have witnessed with great concern the disturbing social unrest in your nation in these past days, following the tragic death of



Mr. George Floyd. My friends, we cannot tolerate or turn a blind eye to racism and exclusion in any form and yet claim to defend the sacredness of every human life. At the same time, we have to recognize that the violence of recent nights is self-destructive and self-defeating. Nothing is gained by violence and so much is lost. Today I join the Church in Saint Paul and Minneapolis, and in the entire United States, in praying for the repose of the soul George Floyd and of all those others who have lost their lives as a result of the sin of racism. Let us pray for the consolation of their grieving families and friends and let us implore the national reconciliation and peace for which we yearn. May Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mother of America, intercede for all those who work for peace and justice in your land and throughout the world. May God bless all of you and your families."




