In Jesus, we find comfort and strength. In his prayer to his loving Father, *Abba*, or best translated as papa, Jesus reminds us of his intimate relationship with the Father and the loving and personal relationship he wants with each of us. He hears the cry of the poor and suffering, those "who labor and are burdened" and invites us to find rest in him. "Come to me," he commands with tenderness, "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."

Our Lord wants to take on our burdens by uniting his yoke with ours. Like two oxen working in the field, doing much more together than either could do alone, Jesus wants us to unite our lives with his. In doing so nothing is impossible for us. His tender love makes us one. He gives us rest and renewed strength to do the Father's will. To live in his love as his disciples. And with him to take on the yoke of others. Living and revealing, as Paul tells us, the life and power of the Spirit of God dwelling within us!

Maintaining God's House: 1st Week of Construction

After many years of planning and design effort and nearly six months working with Monterey County we are delighted to announce that our building project is about to begin! This a momentous occasion for the parish and a strong demonstration of our strength as a Catholic community.

On Monday June 15, we obtained our building permit from Monterey County and on the same day signed our agreement with our contractor, Westwood Construction. We began this past Monday, June 29, construction. While construction timelines in a major remodel project like ours can face challenges, our contract calls for a ten month time to completion. We hope this will end up being a month or two shorter. A goal is to be completed by Easter 2021!

The demolition completed this week includes the bathrooms and the two rooms across from the bathrooms where meetings and classes have taken place. The plan for this next week is to begin the demolition of the concrete. We hope to keep everyone up to date on the project and will do our best to include photos on our parish website.


