

The image of Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, holding tenderly the Child Jesus close to her heart, is a precious and touching sign of Mary's faithfulness and eternal love. We can't help but recall her annunciation and God's promise from the angel Gabriel, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you." We celebrate our Feast Day with Mary's desire, as well as our own, to do God's will by entrusting our needs to the Holy Spirit for help. As Saint Paul reminds us, "The one who searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because he intercedes for the holy ones according to God's will."

Our gospel tells us that God, "may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field." Although weeds were among the wheat, the man didn't want to rid his field of the weeds until harvest. God is merciful, just and kind. He awaits our change of heart. The Spirit is present to aid us, as is Mary. *Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, accompany and guide us with your love!*


