
## Twenty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

### GOSPEL READINGS FOR THE WEEK

"Whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."—Matt 16:25

Like Jeremiah in today's First Reading and Peter in our Gospel, we often want to hide and turn away from what God is asking of us. Baptized in the Spirit, being faithful to our call as prophets and disciples of Jesus asks more of us than we think is possible. We see our weaknesses and hear voices tempting us to be quiet, to hold back from living our faith and mission. The cross is more than we can accept. But then, suddenly, we hear his words, "Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." We are awakened by the call deep within us. To save ourselves is to love others. "What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?" Jesus asks us.

Paul makes it very clear, "I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship. Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect."

Gravel, moisture barrier, and re-bar for the new hall floor slab and south footings and foundation has been installed. This will be inspected this Monday with the concrete pour scheduled for Wednesday. 


