Today we begin our Advent journey. A journey of hope calling us to be alert and watchful! Pope Francis tells us very clearly, "Advent is the time we are given to welcome the Lord who comes to encounter us, and also to verify our longing for God, to look forward and prepare ourselves for Christ's return. He will return to us in the celebration of Christmas when we will remember his historic coming in the humility of the human condition; but he enters our heart each time we are willing to receive him; and he will come again at the end of time." Therefore, we must always be vigilant and await the Lord with generous love and hope! "Be alert!"

Psalm 80 is a prayer of a people that has experienced great pain and disaster. The psalm reminds us of our own experience in the darkness of the pandemic. Advent calls us to turn to God in our pain. Paul, too, assures us of God's faithfulness and action in our lives. He speaks of a community that acts with love for others as a true witness to our Lord. May we, too, be alert with love as we await his return. "Be watchful!"

#### Lectio Divina for the First Week of Advent

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#### **Prayer:**

Keep us alert, we pray, O Lord our God, as we await the advent of Christ your Son, so that, when he comes and knocks, he may find us watchful in prayer and exultant in his praise. He who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

**Reading:** Read the following Scripture two or three times—**Mark 13:33-37** 

**Meditation:** After the reading, take time to reflect in silence on one or more of the following questions: What word or words in this passage caught your attention? What in the passage comforted you? What in this passage challenged you?

**Prayer:** Read the Scripture passage one more time. Bring to the Lord the praise, petition, or thanksgiving that the Word inspires in you.

**Contemplation:** Read the Scripture again, followed by this reflection—What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

"Be watchful! Be alert!" How can I become more attentive to the presence of God in my life? How can I be more attentive to the needs of those around me?

"You do not know when the time will come."
How am I preparing to meet Christ when he comes again? Does the way I spend my time reflect the priority of Christ in my life?

After a period of silent reflection recite the Lord's prayer and Psalm 80. Live the Word with generous love and hope this week.


