### GOSPEL READINGS FOR THE WEEK

"I do will it. Be made clean." — Mark 1:41

Pope Francis tells us, "True compassion does not marginalize anyone, nor does it humiliate and exclude; much less consider the disappearance of a person as a good thing." During Jesus' time, lepers were marginalized by society. They are considered sinners. In addition to their physical suffering, they were considered outcasts and unclean, unwanted and unwelcome. This Sunday, a leper kneels and begs Jesus, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Mark tells us that Jesus is moved with compassion. He stretches out his hands and touches the man saying, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. The passage concludes with Jesus, the compassionate healer, remaining "outside in deserted places." It is as if he trades places with the leper.

We will soon find ourselves in the deserted places of Lent. As repentant sinners, on Ash Wednesday we recognize our need for the Lord's compassionate and gentle touch. In the words of our psalmist, "I turn to you, Lord, in times of trouble, and you fill me with the joy of salvation."
