
## First Sunday of Lent

### **GOSPEL READINGS FOR THE WEEK**

"The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert."—Mark 1:12

Just as the season of Lent reflects Jesus' 40 days in the desert, we too are called to follow Jesus into the desert. Doing so, we prepare ourselves spiritually to share in his triumph over sin and death at Easter. Lent is a time for intensive prayer, fasting and giving—especially in service to the poor. As our reading from Genesis reminds us, Noah's 40 days in the waters of the great flood led to a new covenant with God. We, too, experience this Lent a return to God that leads us beyond ourselves to a life of faithfulness as servants and disciples of Jesus. The temptation of sin will always exist, but if we live prayerfully with the strength and power of the Spirit, we like Jesus will receive the grace to remain faithful to the Father.

"Lent" comes from the old English "eternal springtime"—the springtime of our souls! New birth comes forth! Let's accept with joy the gift of Lent and emerge with Jesus from our 40 days in the desert empowered by the resurrection to live the good news. "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel!"
