Pope Francis tells us in his latest encyclical *Fratelli Tutti*, "It is an act of charity to assist someone suffering, but it is also an act of charity, even if we do not know that person, to work to change the social conditions that caused his or her suffering." This Sunday in the Gospel of John, Jesus seeks to change the social conditions impacting the poor and suffering by the greed of the money changers and the sale of animals in the temple. The exploitation of God's people, and the temple itself, is unacceptable to Jesus. Like prophets before him, Jesus speaks out: "Stop making my Father's house a marketplace." His words and actions are an attempt to change the unjust and oppressive temple worship. It is sinful and not the will of God.

These days of Lent, as Exodus reminds us, call us to worship God alone. "I, the Lord, am your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery. You shall not have other gods besides me." Faithfulness to God and neighbor is our responsibility. May our prayer, fasting and care for the poor and suffering free us from sin and empower us with love.
