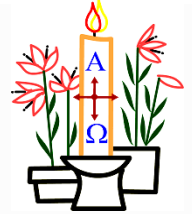
“Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting.” Psalm 118

Divine Mercy Sunday—First Reading: Acts 4:32-35; Psalm 118;
Second Reading: 1 John 5:1-6; Gospel of John 20:19-31

“As the Father has sent me, so I send you.”—John 20:21

Psalm 118 beautifully proclaims, “His mercy endures forever!” The divine mercy of our Lord is given to the disciples in hiding on the first Easter evening. The Risen Christ appears through locked doors and offers peace to his fearful followers. He commissions and sends them forth with the power of the Spirit. “As the Father has sent me, so I send you,” Jesus tells them. It is the same message that each one of us receives anew during this Easter Season. We are reminded this Sunday and throughout Easter that the mercy of God is to be lived and shared. For this reason, Jesus sends us forth.

Although, like Thomas, we were not present on the first Easter evening, with hearts of deep faith we proclaim with strength and joy, “My Lord and my God!” With the early Church in Acts this Sunday, we are called to live and serve with “one heart and mind.” The Risen Christ, present among us with the gift of his Spirit, continues to empower us as believers to experience and live his mission and ministry today. “His mercy endures forever!”

Saint Faustina had declared mercy to be the greatest attribute of God. May it too be my greatest attribute.

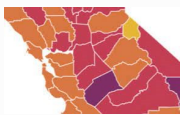
Jesus, I trust in you.

Important Update on Orange Tier Assignment

We received this week an email from the Diocese in light of the County of Monterey moving to the Orange Tier. Governor Newsom announced that the state will fully reopen by June 15, as long as there is enough vaccine supply so that everyone 16 and older will be able to be vaccinated and the hospitalization rates remain stable.



At this point, churches within the county will be able to increase occupancy to 50% of the building's seating capacity. The face mask, social distancing, health check and cleaning protocols will still remain the same. Parishes also have the option of continuing outdoor Masses, as well as the celebration of other sacraments outdoors, if the outside location has a greater capacity than the church building, which is our case at OLMC. For now, we will continue celebrating Masses in our outdoor chapel. We will consider in the future, as appropriate, other options to best meet the needs of our parish.

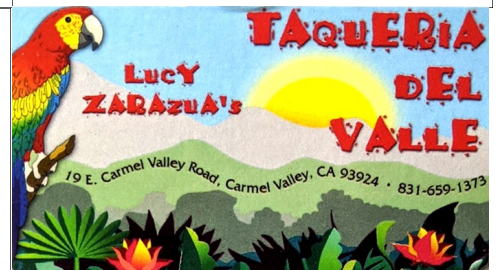
