It is Pentecost, the fiftieth day of Easter, the day of the Holy Spirit! Our readings are a powerful reminder of our unity, and yet our diversity, as people of God. The powerful wind, the tongues of fire, the gift of languages, the breath of life are signs of God’s presence. We are empowered by the Spirit of God! Pentecost is about the birth of a sent community—the Body of Christ—the Church! Through baptism doors are open to us. The Lord of life and love breathes upon us, freeing and gifting us with the wonder and power of a new life. The disciples, free of fear, witness boldly and joyfully their faith!
