
The Most Holy Trinity

GOSPEL READINGS FOR THE WEEK

Mon: Luke 1:39-56 Tues: Mark 12:13-17 Wed: Mark 12:18-27 Thurs: Mark 12:28-34 Fri: Mark 12:35-37

"Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own."—Psalm 33 First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40; Psalm 33; Second Reading: Romans 8:14-17; Gospel of Matthew 28:16-20

"Behold, I am with you always."—Matt 28:20

One of the most famous icons of the Holy Trinity was painted by the Russian artist Andrei Rublev in approximately 1410, during a great famine in Russia. It can be seen to our left and is said to be about hospitality, openness, welcoming and drawing all into sharing at the table. It is a sign of hope that we are invited to sit at the table and share with joy the great feast of love!

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus tells his followers, "All power in heaven and on earth is given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." We are transformed and sent to welcome and receive others at the Holy Trinity's great feast of love!

Christianity grew rapidly in the early church because others could see how followers of Jesus lived. It wasn't so much by preaching, but by their love, kindness and compassion. They lived like Jesus, for others. And we live in communion with them through the Most Holy Trinity—as one family!


