We celebrate the very special Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. At every liturgy during the Eucharistic Prayer we remember the Last Supper. Jesus' selfless act of love and friendship becomes present to us as simple gifts of bread and wine are transformed into Christ himself—so that we, too, can be transformed! We hear anew the words of Jesus, "This is my body" and "This is my blood." We accept him as our food and drink—our very life blood. The fragile, beaten, scourged, and pierced body of Jesus is offered to us. As we receive his Body and Blood we enter into a life of peace, mercy, healing and justice. We share in his work of nonviolence. And we become what we have received—His Love.

This Sunday and in every Eucharist we enter into communion with God's family here in our parish and throughout the world. We also enter into the suffering of those who, like Jesus, are poor, marginalized, and victims of violence and hatred. We gather at our common table with love, unity and mission—to go forth to transform our lives and our world!

Maintaining God's House 48th Week of Construction

We have had a very busy week as we near completion of our project. Flooring was completed this week, as has asphalt paving work and the repair of our drainage issue on El Caminito. The commemorative bricks have also been installed. We also received project approval from the Monterey County Fire District, with a few follow-up items we need to address. With completion of ADA striping and signage at the entry of the new hall, and installation of railings we should be ready for final inspection in the next week or two.
