Mark tells us that Jairus, a synagogue official, pleaded with faith in Jesus for his daughter to be healed, saying, "Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." Although Jairus and Jesus were informed by the crowd that the little girl had died, Jesus told the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." When Jesus entered the room of the little girl, "He took the child by the hand and said to her, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" Immediately, she got up and walked around.

According to Archbishop Tutu, each of us can give life to others. Like the first disciples, let us reach out with the compassionate heart of Jesus. Then all will know God's loving and life-giving presence with them. May our actions give new life and joy to others—and turn "mourning into dancing!"

# California Department of Health Guidelines and Our Masses in our OLMC Chapel

We will continue during the month of June with our Sunday Masses in our outdoor chapel. **Our return to our regular schedule** will take place next weekend, on Saturday evening, July 3 at 4:30 pm, and Sunday morning, July 4 at 9:00 am and 11:15 am, and 5:00 pm in Spanish.

## California Department of Health has made some important changes:

- Masks are not required for those vaccinated, but are required for those who are not vaccinated.
- The 6 ft. safe distancing is no longer required for indoor and outdoor services.
- Hand sanitizers will be located at the entrances main entrance of the church.
- The distribution of the Precious Blood will continue to be suspended at this time until further notice.
- Communion on the tongue can resume.
- The sign of peace can take place, either as a gesture or a traditional handshake.
- Bulletins and song books can take place. Sanitizing between services is no longer required.
- Congregational singing is now allowed, but those who are not vaccinated must wear a mask or refrain from singing.
- Restrictions for gatherings and receptions previously issued are no longer required.
- Altar servers may resume their ministry.
