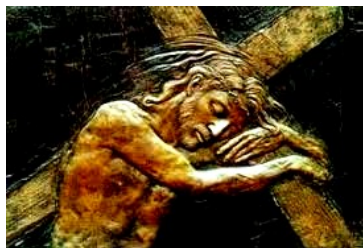

Our readings this Sunday are about prophets in our midst. Individuals driven by the power of the Spirit and the Word of God. Prophets speak the truth and are often rejected because of it. We experience the rejection that Ezekiel, Paul and Jesus all witnessed because of their faithfulness to God. As baptized followers of Christ, each one of us is called to live the prophetic mission of our Lord. Recently canonized Saint Oscar Romero of El Salvador reminds us that living and proclaiming the Gospel of Love is rejected by many. He was shot and killed while celebrating Mass for the sick in a hospital chapel. Each of us is called to live faithfully the love of Christ.

Saint Paul tells us, "I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and constraints, for the sake of Christ; for when I am weak, then I am strong." Like Paul, let us always find our strength in the Gospel of Jesus. As I prepare to leave our special parish, I do so with deep gratitude to God and all of you. May we embrace with deep love the Most Sacred Heart of the Crucified Jesus and always pray for one another. —Fr. Dennis

Our Return to Mass in our OLMC Chapel

Our return to our regular schedule will take place this Saturday, July 3 at 4:30 pm, and Sunday, July 4 at 9:00 am and 11:15 am, and 5:00 pm in Spanish. Our week-day Masses are at 12:00 Noon, Wednesday-Friday.

California Department of Health has made some important changes:

- ◆ Masks are not required for those vaccinated, but are required for those who are not vaccinated.
- ◆ The 6 ft. safe distancing is no longer required for indoor and outdoor services.
- ◆ Hand sanitizers will be located at the entrances main entrance of the church.
- ◆ The distribution of the Precious Blood will continue to be suspended at this time until further notice.
- ◆ Communion on the tongue can resume.
- ◆ The sign of peace can take place, either as a gesture or a traditional handshake.
- ◆ Bulletins and song books can take place. Sanitizing between services is no longer required.
- ◆ Congregational singing is now allowed, but those who are not vaccinated must wear a mask or refrain from singing.
- ◆ Restrictions for gatherings and receptions previously issued are no longer required.
- ◆ Altar servers may resume their ministry.

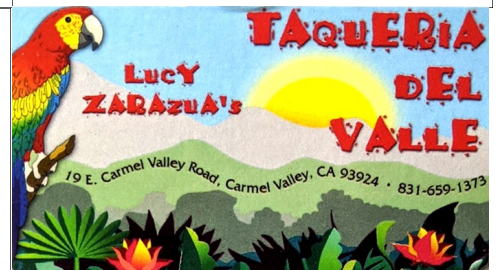
