## Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time October 16-17, 2021

1st Reading: Is 53:10-11; Psalm 33; 2nd Reading: Heb 4: 14-16; Gospel Mk 10:35-45 or 10:42-45

**“Whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant”**



This Markan pericope provides an insight into our Lord's self-understanding, and into an understanding of leadership in the Christian community. In this Gospel the Twelve are not always portrayed in the best light, and are weak, lacking in faith, betray and deny Jesus. This may be deliberate on Mark's part in order to encourage the Roman Christians for whom Mark was probably written, and who have suffered grievously in their time of trial under the Emperor Nero. If those who are closest to Jesus can get things so wrong, there is hope for all Christians. So, two of the Twelve, James and John, approach Jesus and call him "Teacher," equivalent to "Rabbi." This very form of address suggests their lack of understanding. Jesus is not a teacher, but Lord, and the suffering-beloved Son of God (see Mark 1.1, 11; 9.7; 15.39). But their failure does not remain at the level of address. They desire positions of importance and power at Jesus' right and left hands, when he comes into his glory. That the Twelve should think in these terms was shameful, and in the parallel passage in St. Matthew, the author makes the request come from the mother of James and John. Jesus, in response, contrasts the style of the kyrios/lord and the diakonos/servant. The great ones among the Gentiles demonstrate their importance by playing at being lords/kyrioi over others. Among his followers, however, service/diakonia is what is distinctive. The Son of Man came to be a diakonos/deacon/servant and to give his life for others. © 2003, OCP. All rights reserved

### St. Luke, Evangelist

Early historians said this author of the third Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles was born to a pagan family in Antioch (Turkey) and converted to Christianity. According to Paul's letters and Acts, he was a doctor and Paul's companion during his later journeys and imprisonment in Rome. Luke's New Testament writings in Greek were for gentiles, extending to them the salvation promised to Israel. 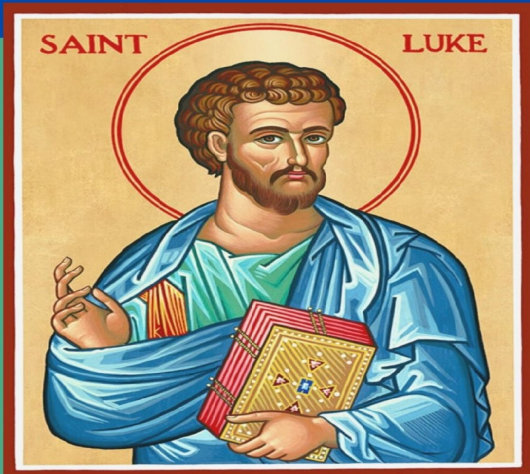

## XXIX Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

1era. Lectura: Is 53, 10-11; Salmo: 32;

2da. Lectura: Heb 4, 14-16; Evangelio: Mc 10, 35-45

### “El que quiera ser grande entre ustedes que sea su servidor”

Esta perícopa del Evangelio de Marcos nos proporciona una visión de la auto comprensión de nuestro Señor y de la comprensión del liderazgo en la comunidad cristiana. En este Evangelio, los Doce no siempre son retratados de la mejor manera, y son débiles, faltos de fe, traicionan y niegan a Jesús. Esto puede ser deliberado por parte de Marcos para alentar a los cristianos romanos para quienes probablemente Marcos escribió, y que han sufrido mucho en su tiempo de prueba bajo el emperador Nerón. Si los más cercanos a Jesús pueden hacer las cosas tan mal, hay esperanza para todos los cristianos. Entonces, dos de los Doce, Santiago y Juan, se acercan a Jesús y lo llaman "Maestro", equivalente a "Rabí". Esta misma forma de dirigirse sugiere su falta de comprensión. Jesús no es un maestro, sino el Señor, y el sufriente y amado Hijo de Dios (ver Marcos 1.1, 11; 9.7; 15.39). Pero su fracaso no se queda a nivel de su salud. Desean puestos de importancia y poder a la derecha y a la izquierda de Jesús, cuando llegue a su gloria. Que los Doce pensarán en estos términos era vergonzoso, y en el pasaje paralelo de San Mateo, el autor hace que la petición provenga de la madre de Santiago y Juan. Jesús, en respuesta, contrasta el estilo del kyrios / señor y el diakonos / siervo. Los grandes entre los gentiles demuestran su importancia como señores / kyrioi sobre otros. Entre sus seguidores, sin embargo, el servicio / diaconía es lo que se distingue. El Hijo del Hombre vino para ser diakonos / diácono / siervo y para dar su vida por los demás.

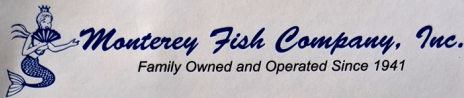
