1st Reading: 1Kgs 17: 10-16 6:2-6; Psalm 146; 2nd Reading: Heb 9: 24-28; Gospel Mk 12:38-44

A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents



The first and Gospel readings are often paired by motif, giving a certain continuity to the Scripture passages chosen. Thus, we find ourselves today back with the widows we discussed in the commentary on the first reading. Jesus criticizes the treatment of these women by those who should be most sympathetic to their plight. Then he holds one such person up as an example that might well shame more than one of his listeners. Like the widow Elijah encountered, the widow at the Temple treasury is literally down to her last small coins. Yet, also like the widow in Elijah, she is willing to sacrifice what little she has for a cause she deems greater. However,

unlike her earlier counterpart, Jesus' widow is not tangibly rewarded for her generosity, or if she was, we are not told. Most of us would relate better to Jesus' model. We can probably cite instances in our own lives where our exceptional liberality apparently went unnoticed or even unappreciated. That may be a great blessing. As Jesus says in his Sermon on the Mount, "...your Father who sees what is hidden will repay you." (Matthew 6:18b) The little that we can do may not place our names on distinguished buildings or philanthropic foundations, but, like the widow who gave from her want rather than her surplus, it may make all the difference. Saint of the week: November 13th
St. Frances Cabrini

(1850-1917) In 1946, Mother Cabrini was the first U.S. citizen to be canonized; she is the universal patron of immigrants. She was born in Italy, the youngest of 13 children, and became a schoolteacher. Denied admission to two religious orders because of frail health, she was given charge of an orphanage in Codogno. In 1880 she founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart with seven of her former orphans. The order spread rapidly from northern Italy to Rome, and then in 1889 to New York City, where Mother Cabrini became famous for her work among Italian immigrants. Before dying of malaria in Chicago, she had opened schools, orphanages and hospitals around the United States, South America and Europe. © 2021, United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Santa de la semana: Noviembre 13
Santa Francisca Cabrini

(1850-1917) En 1946, la Madre Cabrini fue la primera ciudadana estadounidense en ser canonizada; ella es la patrona universal de los inmigrantes. Francisca nació en Italia, era la menor de 13 hermanos y era maestra de escuela. Dos órdenes religiosas le negaron el ingreso debido a su delicada salud pero la dejaron encargada de un orfanato en Codogno. En 1880, ella fundó a las Hermanas Misioneras del Sagrado Corazón junto con siete de sus antiguos huérfanos. La orden se extendió rápidamente desde el norte de Italia hasta Roma y, luego, en 1889, a la ciudad de Nueva York en donde la Madre Cabrini se hizo famosa por su labor entre los inmigrantes italianos. (Mateo 6: 18b) Es posible que lo poco que podamos hacer no coloque nuestros nombres en edificios distinguidos o fundaciones filantrópicas, pero, como la viuda que dio de su necesidad en lugar de su excedente, puede marcar la diferencia. 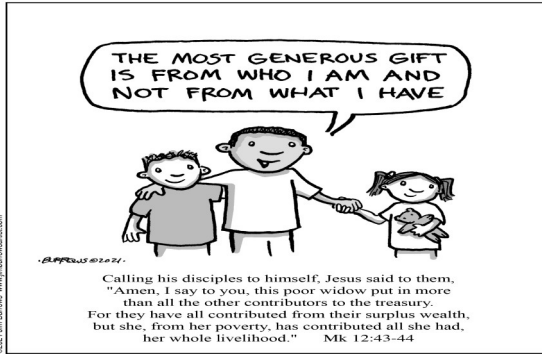

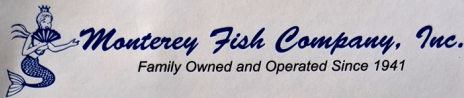
