1st Reading: Is 6: 1-2a 3-8 Psalm 138; 2nd Reading: 1 Cor 12: 15: 1-11 Gospel: Lk 5: 1-11

## “Put out into deep water”



Within this passage we can distinguish three separate scenes (a description of the places where Jesus’ preaching occurs, the wondrous catch of fish, Simon’s call) but they are all composed within a perfectly unified tableau as they are centered on the miracle and on the person of Simon, while Jesus’ preaching from the boat is merely an accessory and secondary element. His confident abandon to the command of Jesus, caused by faith more than obedience, the reactions of stupor in the face of Jesus’ miracle, are presented by Luke through the prism of Peter’s spiritual awakening.

Jesus’ wonderworking power, manifested so clearly, verified so closely, is a lightning bolt as it both rouses and dominates Simon. His resultant exclamation reflects the spontaneous and genuine awareness of being a sinner, a reflex-rection of consciousness that surfaces whenever a creature is involved in an immediate, almost tangible experience of the divine. This renders him capable of comprehending the tranquilizing word of Jesus as a tacit but clear invitation to mission and it motivates Simon to the point of accepting it and, in so doing, he makes of himself a model for his companions. **Saint of the week: Feb. 8th**  
**St. Josephine Bakhita**

St. Josephine Bakhita was born in Sudan in 1869 and enslaved as a child. Eventually she was sold to an Italian diplomat and taken to Italy, where she was later brought to freedom through the help of the Canossian Daughters of Charity. Through their guidance, she learned about God and served him faithfully until her death in 1947.

Today, the feast day for St. Josephine Bakhita—February 8—is recognized as the annual day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking. Through prayer, we not only reflect on the experiences of those that have suffered through this affront to human dignity but also comfort, strengthen, and help empower survivors. **Santa de la semana: Feb 8**  
**Santa Josefina Bakhita**

(Santa Josefina Bakhita nació en Sudan en 1869 y, cuando niña, fue esclava. Con el tiempo, ella fue vendida a un diplomático italiano y llevada a Italia en donde más adelante fue liberada mediante la ayuda de las Canosianas Hijas de la Caridad. Bajo su guía, ella aprendió sobre Dios y lo sirvió fielmente hasta su fallecimiento en 1947.

Hoy, la fiesta de santa Josefina Bakhita—8 de febrero—es reconocida como la jornada anual de oración y reflexión contra la trata de personas. A través de la oración, no solo reflexionamos acerca de las experiencias de las personas que han sufrido esta afrenta a la dignidad humana sino que también ayudamos, consolamos, fortalecemos y empoderamos a los sobrevivientes.

**Quinto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario**

**1era. Lectura:** Is 6, 1-2a. 3-8 **Salmo:** 137;

**2da.lectura:** 1 Cor 15, 1-11 **Evangelio:** Lk 5, 1-11

*“Lleva la barca mar adentro”*

Simon, mientras que la predicación de Jesús desde la barca es sólo un elemento accesorio y secundario. Su abandono confiado al mandato de Jesús, provocado por la fe más que por la obediencia, las reacciones de estupor ante el milagro de Jesús, son presentadas por Lucas a través del prisma del despertar espiritual de Pedro.

El poder milagroso de Jesús, manifestado tan claramente, verificado tan de cerca, es un relámpago que despierta y domina a Simón. Su exclamación resultante refleja la conciencia espontánea y genuina de ser un pecador, un reflejo-reflexión de la conciencia que aflora cada vez que una criatura está involucrada en una experiencia inmediata, casi tangible de lo divino. Esto lo hace capaz de comprender la palabra tranquilizadora de Jesús como una tácita pero clara invitación a la misión y motiva a Simón hasta el punto de aceptarla y, al hacerlo, se convierte en modelo para sus compañeros.

Dentro de este pasaje podemos distinguir tres escenas separadas (una descripción de los lugares donde se produce la predicación de Jesús, la pesca milagrosa, la llamada de Simón) pero todas están compuestas dentro de un cuadro perfectamente unificado, ya que están centradas en el milagro y en la persona de

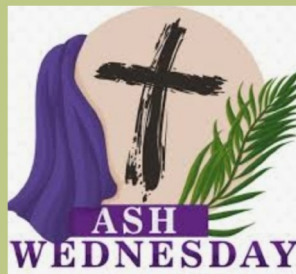

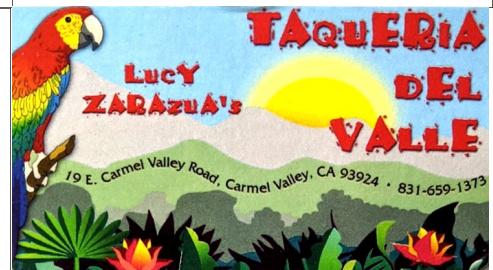
