Second Sunday of Lent March 12-13, 2022

1st Reading: Gn. 15:5-12, 17-18 Psalm 27; 2nd Reading: Philp. 3:17-4:1 Gospel: Lk 9: 28b-36

"He will change our lowly body to conform with his gloried body"



For the second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus' retreat to the desert to his Transfiguration. Each year on the first Sunday of Lent, our Gospel tells the story of Jesus' temptation in the desert. On the second Sunday of Lent each year, we hear the story of Jesus' Transfiguration.

The story of Jesus' Transfiguration is told in the three Synoptic Gospels: Matthew, Mark, and Luke. In each of those Gospels, the Transfiguration follows Jesus' first prediction of his death and his teaching about the costs of discipleship. Jesus' Transfiguration is a promise of Jesus' glory, his Resurrection.

On a mountain in today's reading, a voice affirms that Jesus is God's Son in words reminiscent of the voice at Jesus' baptism. In addition, the appearance of Moses and Elijah on the mountain connects this story with God's relationship to the people of Israel. Moses and Elijah represent the Law and the

Prophets, respectively. Together with Jesus, they represent God's complete Word.

The Transfiguration occurs in the presence of just three of Jesus' disciples: Peter, James, and John. In Matthew's Gospel, those disciples are among the first whom Jesus calls. The three men are identified as an "inner circle" among Jesus' disciples when Jesus asks them to accompany him to the Garden of Gethsemane just before his arrest.

Saint of the week: March. 19th
St. Joseph



The spouse of Mary the mother of Jesus and the legal father of Jesus according to Jewish law, Joseph is a model of humility and obedience to God's will. He followed God's instructions, given by angels in dreams, and took the pregnant Mary into his home as his wife, protected her and Jesus at the child's birth in Bethlehem through the family's sojourn in Egypt, and provided for them as a carpenter in Nazareth. This feast, which was celebrated locally as early as the ninth century, became a universal feast in the fifteenth century, when it was placed on the liturgical calendar. Pope Pius IX named St. Joseph Patron of the Universal Church in 1870; he is also the patron saint of carpenters, the dying, and workers. United States Conference of Catholic Bishops

José, esposo de María, la madre de Jesús, y padre legal de Jesús según la ley judía, es un modelo de humildad y de obediencia a la voluntad de Dios. Él siguió las instrucciones de Dios, dadas por unos ángeles durante un sueño y llevó a su hogar a María, encinta, como su esposa; la protegió a ella y a Jesús cuando el niño nació en Belén durante la estadía de la familia en Egipto y los cuidó y proveyó para ellos como carpintero en Nazaret. Esta fiesta, la cual ya se celebraba localmente en el siglo IX, se convirtió en fiesta universal en el siglo XV, cuando fue incluida en el calendario litúrgico. En 1870, el papa Pío IX nombró a San José como Patrón de la Iglesia Universal; él también es el santo patrón de los carpinteros, los moribundos y los trabajadores.

En una montaña en la lectura de hoy, una voz afirma que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios en palabras que recuerdan la voz en el bautismo de Jesús. Además, la aparición de Moisés y Elías en la montaña conecta esta historia con la relación de Dios con el pueblo de Israel. Moisés y Elías representan la Ley y los Profetas, respectivamente. Junto con Jesús, representan la Palabra completa de Dios.

La Transfiguración ocurre en presencia de sólo tres de los discípulos de Jesús: Pedro, Santiago y Juan. En el Evangelio de Mateo, esos discípulos están entre los primeros a quienes Jesús llama. Estos tres apóstoles se identifican como un "círculo íntimo" entre los discípulos de Jesús cuando Jesús les pide que lo acompañen al Jardín de Getsemaní justo antes de su arresto.

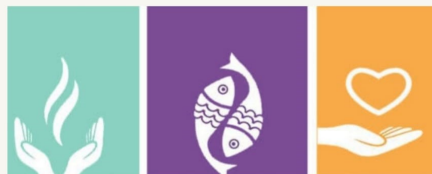

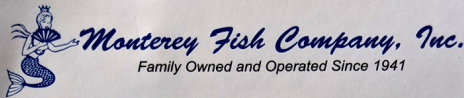

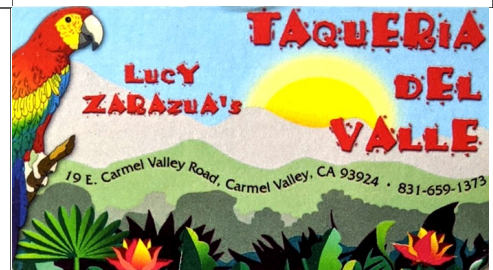
