## Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. September 25, 2022

1st Reading: Am 6:1a, 4-7 Psalm 146 2nd Reading: 1 Tm 6:11-16 Gospel: Lk 16:19-31

### "Beggar at the Gate"



A major theme in the Gospel of Luke is the importance of the care of the poor in the life of discipleship. In the parable found in today's Gospel, Jesus contrasts the life of a rich man and the poor man, Lazarus, who lives in the shadow of the rich man and his wealth.

In the context of Luke's Gospel, this parable, delivered in the presence of a crowd of listeners, is part of Jesus' response to some Pharisees. These Pharisees are described in Luke's Gospel as "loving money." (Note: The Pharisees were followers of a sect of Judaism active before, during, and after Jesus' lifetime.

They taught an oral interpretation of the Law of Moses as the basis for popular Jewish piety. They put less emphasis on Temple worship and more on applying the law to everyday life. Though they are often portrayed negatively in the Gospels, they shared many of Jesus' and the early Church's concerns about the law.) Jesus observed that the actions of some Pharisees betrayed misplaced priorities: they spoke one way but acted in another. The story of the rich man and Lazarus demonstrates the importance of the care of the poor and is a reminder to those who would follow Jesus of the unimportance of wealth in the eyes of God.

**Saint of the week: September 30th  
Saint Jerome**



Born to a rich pagan family, Jerome led a misspent youth. Studied in Rome. Lawyer. Converted in theory, and baptized in 365, he began his study of theology, and had a true conversion. Monk. Lived for years as a hermit in the Syrian deserts. Priest. Student of Saint Gregory of Nazianzen. Secretary to Pope Damasus I who commissioned him to revise the Latin text of the Bible. The result of his 30 years of work was the Vulgate translation, which is still in use. He lived his last 34 years in the Holy Land as a semi-recluse. Wrote translations of histories, biographies, the works of Origen, and much more. Doctor of the Church, Father of the Church. Since his own time, he has been associated in the popular mind with scrolls, writing, cataloging, translating, which led to those who work in such fields taking him as their patron — a man who knew their lives and problems. **Santo de la semana: Septiembre 30  
San Jeronimo**

Nacido en una rica familia pagana, Jeronimo lideró una juventud malgastada. Estudió en Roma. Abogado. Convertido en teoría y bautizado en el año 365, comenzó sus estudios de teología y tuvo una verdadera conversión. Monje. Vivió durante años como ermitaño en los desiertos sirios. Sacerdote. Alumno de San Gregorio Nacienceno. Secretario del Papa Dámaso I, quien le encargó revisar el texto latino de la Biblia. El resultado de sus 30 años de trabajo fue la traducción de la Vulgata, que todavía está en uso. Vivió sus últimos 34 años en Tierra Santa como un semi-recluso. Escribió traducciones de historias, biografías, las obras de Orígenes y mucho más. Doctor de la Iglesia, Padre de la Iglesia. Desde su propia época, ha estado asociado en la mente popular con los pergaminos, la escritura, la catalogación, la traducción, lo que llevó a quienes trabajan en esos campos a tomarlo como su patron.

**XXVI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario**

**1era. Lectura:** Am 6, 1. 4-7 **Salmo:** 145; **2da.Lectura:** 1 Tm 6, 11-16 **Evangelio:** Lc 16,19-31

**“El mendigo en la puerta ”**

Un tema principal en el Evangelio de Lucas es la importancia del cuidado de los pobres en la vida del discipulado. En la parábola del Evangelio de hoy, Jesús contrasta la vida del rico y la del pobre, Lázaro, que vive a la sombra del rico y de sus riquezas.

En el contexto del Evangelio de Lucas, esta parábola, pronunciada en presencia de una multitud de oyentes, es parte de la respuesta de Jesús a algunos fariseos. Estos fariseos se describen en el Evangelio de Lucas como "amantes del dinero". (Nota: Los fariseos eran seguidores de una secta del judaísmo activa antes, durante y después de la vida de Jesús. Enseñaban una interpretación oral de la Ley de Moisés como base para la piedad judía popular. Ponían menos énfasis en la adoración en el Templo y más en la aplicación de la ley a la vida cotidiana. Aunque a menudo se los describe negativamente en los Evangelios, compartían muchas de las preocupaciones de Jesús y de la Iglesia primitiva acerca de la ley.) Jesús observó que las acciones de algunos fariseos traicionaban prioridades fuera de lugar: hablaban de una manera pero actuaban en otra. La historia del hombre rico y Lázaro demuestra la importancia del cuidado de los pobres y es un recordatorio para aquellos que siguen a Jesús de la falta de importancia de la riqueza a los ojos de Dios.
