The second parable that Jesus tells in Luke 18 addresses attitude in prayer. In contrasting the prayer of the Pharisee with the prayer of the tax collector, Jesus teaches his disciples to pray in humility before God. Jesus again surprises his listeners by showing the tax collector as the example of faith, rather than the Pharisee. Remember that Pharisees were members of a sect of Judaism active in Jesus' time. They taught an oral interpretation of the Law of Moses as the basis for Jewish piety. If anyone would be a model for prayer, a Pharisee was a likely candidate. In contrast, Jesus offers the tax collector as a model for prayer. Tax collectors were collaborators with the Roman authorities in a system that allowed the tax collectors to line their own pockets by charging in excess of the defined taxes. Yet, in this parable, Jesus offers the humility of the tax collector as a model for the prayer of a disciple. The parable reminds us that when we pray, we must remember our need for God in our lives. If we are too full of ourselves, there is too little room for God's grace to work in us. Loyola Press

Saint of the week: October 28th
Saints Simon and Jude, Apostles

Santo de la semana: Octubre 28
Santos Simón y Judas, Apóstoles

SIMON is mentioned on all four lists of the apostles. In two of them he is called "the Zealot." The Zealots were a Jewish sect that represented an extreme of Jewish nationalism. For them, the messianic promise of the Old Testament meant that the Jews were to be a free and independent nation. Any payment of taxes to the Romans was a blasphemy against God. Many were the counterparts of modern terrorists. They raided and killed, attacking both foreigners and "collaborating" Jews. They were chiefly responsible for the rebellion against Rome which ended in the destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70.



SIMÓN se menciona en las cuatro listas de los apóstoles. En dos de ellos se le llama "el Zelote". Los zelotes eran una secta judía que representaba un extremo del nacionalismo judío. Para ellos, la promesa mesiánica del Antiguo Testamento significaba que los judíos serían una nación libre e independiente. Cualquier pago de impuestos a los romanos era una blasfemia contra Dios. Muchos eran los homólogos de los terroristas modernos. Asaltaron y mataron, atacando tanto a extranjeros como a judíos "colaboradores". Fueron los principales responsables de la rebelión contra Roma que terminó con la destrucción de Jerusalén en el año 70 d.C. JUDAS es llamado así por Lucas y Hechos. Mateo y Marcos lo llaman Tadeo. No se le menciona en ninguna otra parte de los Evangelios, excepto, por supuesto, donde se mencionan todos los apóstoles. Los eruditos sostienen que él no es el autor de la Carta de Judas. En realidad, Judas tenía el mismo nombre que Judas Iscariote.

JUDE is so named by Luke and Acts. Matthew and Mark call him Thaddeus. He is not mentioned elsewhere in the Gospels, except, of course, where all the apostles are mentioned. Scholars hold that he is not the author of the Letter of Jude. Actually, Jude had the same name as Judas Iscariot. Evidently because of the disgrace of that name, it was shortened to "Jude" in English IBreviary

XXX Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

'Dios mío, apiádate de mí, que soy un pecador'

La segunda parábola que Jesús cuenta en Lucas en el capítulo 18 trata sobre la actitud en la oración. Al contrastar la oración del fariseo con la oración del publicano, Jesús enseña a sus discípulos a orar con humildad ante Dios. Jesús vuelve a sorprender a sus oyentes al mostrar al publicano como ejemplo de fe, en lugar del fariseo. Recuerda que los fariseos eran miembros de una secta del judaísmo activa en la época de Jesús. Enseñaron una interpretación oral de la Ley de Moisés como base para la piedad judía. Si alguien quisiera ser un modelo para la oración, un fariseo era un candidato probable. En contraste, Jesús ofrece al publicano como modelo para la oración. Los publicanos eran colaboradores de las autoridades romanas en un sistema que permitía a los publicanos llenarse los bolsillos cobrando en exceso de los impuestos definidos. Sin embargo, en esta parábola, Jesús ofrece la humildad del publicano como modelo para la oración de un discípulo. La parábola nos recuerda que cuando oramos, debemos recordar nuestras necesidades diarias a Dios. Si estamos demasiado llenos de nosotros mismos, hay muy poco espacio para que la gracia de Dios obre en nosotros.
