1st Reading: Wis 11:22-12:2 Psalm 145 2nd Reading: 2 Tm 1:11-2:2 Gospel: Lk 19:1-10

*"Today I must stay at your house"*



In Jesus' day, tax collectors were not popular people. They were collaborators with the Romans and were despised by many Jewish people. The tax system allowed them to charge more than what was required so that they could make a profit for themselves. Thus, they were considered sinners by their countrymen. Observers in the crowd that day grumble because Jesus dines with a sinner. Throughout Scripture, Jesus' choice of dinner companions set him apart from other observant Jews of his time. In first century Jewish culture, to dine together was to show a bond of fellowship and peace among those at the table. Observant Jews did not generally dine with foreigners and sinners. Yet, Jesus chooses to honor the tax collector, Zacchaeus, by staying at his house.

Even before Jesus comes to his home, Zacchaeus shows himself to be someone in search of salvation. Zacchaeus, described as short in stature, climbs a tree in order to see Jesus. We know from Luke's description that Zacchaeus was no ordinary tax collector; he was, in fact, the chief tax collector and a person of some wealth. In his search for salvation, he humbled himself by making a spectacle of himself by climbing a tree.

Jesus recognizes the faith of this tax collector exhibited in his search for salvation and calls him down from the tree. In the hospitality he extends to Jesus and in his conversion of heart, Zacchaeus is raised up by Jesus as a model of salvation.

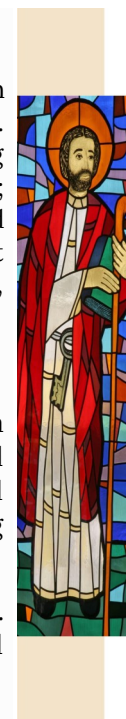
## All Saints Day, Nov. 1st.

On the feast of All Saints, we honor those men and women who—whether they've been canonized or not—have led lives of heroic virtue that set an example for all Christians. Saints are big dreamers. They believe that with God on their side, no one and nothing can stop them. Saints are go-getters. They don't wait for someone else to do good first; they jump right in. Saints are love-bringers. They try to see Christ in every person and every situation. Saints tell us what matters most in life is not what we earn or own, not the job we have or the people we know. What really matters is how much we love God, others, and ourselves, and how well we show that love in all we do.

## All Souls Day, Nov. 2nd

Catholics believe that death can separate people who they love from them for only a while. We are still united with them in the Communion of Saints. On this feast of All Souls, and throughout the entire month of November, we recall our deceased relatives, friends. We pray for them, remembering that likewise these people being purified have the power to intercede us too.

In Mexico, All Souls Day is celebrated as *Día de los Muertos* (the Day of the Dead). Altars are assembled in honor of the departed. Families then go to cemeteries and wash the tombstones and decorate them.

**Saint of the week: November 4th**  
**Saint Charles Borromeo**

**Santo de la semana: Noviembre 4th**  
**Santo Carlos Borromeo**

Carlos Borromeo, Bishop, was appointed Cardinal by his maternal uncle, Pope Pius IV, and elected Bishop of Milan. He was a true and faithful shepherd, as he cared for the needs of the Church of his time, as well as the formation of the clergy. He convened synods and erected seminaries and visited his entire diocese many times to promote Christian customs, and norms for the good of the faithful. He passed to the heavenly homeland in 1584. San Carlos Borromeo is the patron saint of the Carmel Mission, whose formal name is: San Carlos Borromeo del Rio Carmelo. IBreviary



Carlos Borromeo, obispo, que nombrado cardenal por su tío materno, el papa Pío IV, y elegido obispo de Milán, fue en esta sede un verdadero pastor fiel, preocupado por las necesidades de la Iglesia de su tiempo, y para la formación del clero convocó sínodos y erigió seminarios, visitó muchas veces toda su diócesis con el fin de fomentar las costumbres cristianas y dio muchas normas para bien de los fieles. Pasó a la patria celeste en la fecha de ayer (1584). San Carlos Borromeo es el patrono de la Mision de Carmel, cuyo nombre formal es: San Carlos Borromeo del Rio Carmelo.

*XXXI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario*

**1era. Lectura:** Sab. 11,22-12,2 **Salmo:** 144; **2da.Lectura:** 2 Tm 1,11-2,2 **Evangelio:** Lc 19,1-10

*'Hoy tengo que hospedarme en tu casa'*

En los días de Jesús, los publicanos no eran gente de buen ver. Eran colaboradores de los romanos. El sistema tributario les permitía cobrar más de lo requerido para que pudieran obtener ganancias por sí mismos. Por lo tanto, fueron considerados pecadores por sus compatriotas. Los observadores en la multitud ese día se quejan porque Jesús cena con un pecador. A lo largo de las Escrituras, la elección de Jesús de los compañeros de cena lo diferenció de otros judíos observantes de su tiempo. En la cultura judía del primer siglo, cenar juntos era mostrar un vínculo de compañerismo y paz entre los que estaban en la mesa. Los judíos practicantes generalmente no cenaban con extranjeros y pecadores. Sin embargo, Jesús elige honrar al recaudador de impuestos, Zaqueo, quedándose en su casa.

Incluso antes de que Jesús llegue a la casa de Zaqueo se muestra como alguien en busca de la salvación. Zaqueo, descrito como de baja estatura, se sube a un árbol para ver a Jesús. Sabemos por la descripción de Lucas que Zaqueo no era un recaudador de impuestos ordinario; él era, de hecho, el principal recaudador de impuestos y una persona de cierta riqueza. En su búsqueda de la salvación, se humilló a sí mismo haciendo un espectáculo subiéndose a un árbol. Jesús reconoce la fe de este recaudador de impuestos exhibida en su búsqueda de salvación y lo llama a bajar del árbol. En la hospitalidad que brinda a Jesús y en la conversión de su corazón, Zaqueo es elevado por Jesús como modelo de salvación.
