SECOND SUNDAY IN OPDINARY TIME— JANUARY 15, 2023 'I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God'



Today, we hear John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus as found in John's Gospel. John's Gospel differs from the other Gospels because John does not describe Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist. Instead, John the Baptist announces that he knows that Jesus is the Son of God.

In today's reading, John the Baptist sees Jesus approaching and cries out, giving witness about who Jesus is. In John's testimony he says that he saw the Spirit descend upon Jesus. By this sign, John the Baptist knew that Jesus was the one who is to come after him.

John the Baptist uses two titles for Jesus that are familiar to us. John calls Jesus the "Lamb of God" and the "Son of God." By using these titles, John the Baptist identifies Jesus' ultimate purpose: to redeem sinful humanity.

John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus clearly distinguishes John's baptism from the Baptism that Jesus will inaugurate. John baptizes with water; Jesus will baptize with the Holy

Spirit. John also puts his practice of baptism in the context of Jesus' ministry. The purpose of John's baptism was to make Jesus known to Israel.

John the Baptist's sense of purpose is clearly identified in this reading: he baptized in order to prepare for and make known the ministry of the One who was to follow. John's witness is an excellent example of what it means to be a disciple. By our Baptism, we are called to make Jesus known to all the world by our words and by the witness of our lives.

II DOMINGO ORDINARIO- ENERO 15, 2023 'Yo lo ví y doy testímonío de que éste es el Híjo de Díos

Hoy, escuchamos el testimonio de Juan el Bautista acerca de Jesús segun el Evangelio de san Juan. El Evangelio de Juan difiere de los otros Evangelios porque Juan no describe el bautismo de Jesús por Juan el Bautista. En cambio, Juan el Bautista anuncia que sabe que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios.

En la lectura de hoy, Juan el Bautista ve a Jesús acercándose y clama, dando testimonio de quién es Jesús. En el testimonio de Juan dice que vio al Espíritu descender sobre Jesús. Por esta señal, Juan el Bautista sabía que Jesús era el que había de venir después de él.

Juan el Bautista usa dos títulos para Jesús que nos son familiares. Juan llama a Jesús el "Cordero de Dios" y el "Hijo de Dios". Al usar estos títulos, Juan el Bautista identifica el propósito final de Jesús: redimir a la humanidad pecadora.

El testimonio de Juan el Bautista acerca de Jesús distingue claramente el bautismo de Juan del bautismo que Jesús inaugurará. Juan bautiza con agua; Jesús bautizará con el Espíritu Santo. Juan también pone su práctica del bautismo en el contexto del ministerio de Jesús. El propósito del bautismo de Juan era dar a conocer a Jesús a Israel.

El sentido de propósito de Juan el Bautista se identifica claramente en esta lectura: él bautizó para preparar y dar a conocer el ministerio de Aquel que lo seguiría. El testimonio de Juan es un excelente ejemplo de lo que significa ser un discípulo. Por nuestro Bautismo, estamos llamados a dar a conocer a Jesús a todo el mundo con nuestras palabras y con el testimonio de nuestra vida.

The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time, on the other hand, take us through the life of Christ. This is the time of conversion. This is living the life of Christ.

Ordinary Time is a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.
