

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME— FEBRUARY 12TH, 2023
Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!



Matthew continues the Sermon on the Mount. Today's reading is part one and deals with the Law.

When Matthew speaks of "the Law and the prophets" he means the whole Scripture. When the Messiah brings the fullness of the kingdom none of scripture will be done away with. Instead it will be fulfilled. Matthew's Jesus does not overturn the Law of Moses, nor does he set his followers free from the Law. He requires his followers to go beyond the Law by doing more than the Law requires.

The Law condemned murder. Jesus condemns anger. The Law condemned adultery. Jesus condemns even lustful looks. As Jewish Christians who had always been faithful to the Law Matthew's community need a way to understand the difference Jesus and the kingdom he brings have made. They affirmed that God had always been at work in history through "the Law and the prophets." But God's work goes beyond that to be embodied by the Messiah who reveals the definitive will of God. The written scriptures and their interpretation in tradition are surpassed by Jesus whose life and teaching are the definitive revelation of the will of God.



# VI DOMINGO ORDINARIO- FEBRERO 12, 2023 "Díchoso el que cumple la voluntad del Señor"

Mateo continúa el Sermón de la Montaña. La lectura de hoy es la primera parte y trata de la Ley.

Cuando Mateo habla de "la Ley y los profetas" se refiere a toda la Escritura. Cuando el Mesías traiga la plenitud del reino, ninguna de las Escrituras será eliminada. En cambio, se cumplirá. El Jesús de Mateo no anula la Ley de Moisés, ni libera a sus seguidores de la Ley. Él requiere que sus seguidores vayan más allá de la Ley haciendo más de lo que la Ley requiere.

La Ley condenaba el asesinato. Jesús condena la ira. La Ley condenaba el adulterio. Jesús condena incluso las miradas lujuriosas. Como cristianos judíos que siempre han sido fieles a la Ley, la comunidad de Mateo necesita una forma de comprender la diferencia que Jesús y el reino que trae han hecho. Afirmaron que Dios siempre había estado obrando en la historia a través de "la Ley y los profetas". Pero la obra de Dios va más allá para encarnarse en el Mesías que revela la voluntad definitiva de Dios. Las Escrituras y su interpretación en la tradición son superadas por Jesús, cuya vida y enseñanza son la revelación definitiva de la voluntad de Dios.

#### SAINT OF THE WEEK: THE SEVEN HOLY FOUNDERS OF THE SERVITE ORDER

Today the liturgy honors seven noble Florentines who in the thirteenth century, at a time when Florence and all Italy was torn by civil strife, banded together to found, not far from Florence on Monte Senario, the Order of Servites of the Blessed Virgin Mary, especially dedicated to penance and meditation on the sorrows of our Lady in the passion of our Savior. This order was approved by the Holy See in 1304. One of the seven, Alexis Falconieri, died on this date in 1310.



Hoy la liturgia honra a siete nobles florentinos que en el siglo XIII, en un momento en que Florencia y toda Italia estaban desgarradas por las luchas civiles, se unieron para fundar, no lejos de Florencia, en Monte Senario, la Orden de los Siervos de la Santísima Virgen María, especialmente dedicada a la penitencia ya la meditación de los dolores de la Virgen en la pasión del Salvador. Esta orden fue aprobada por la Santa Sede en 1304. Uno de los siete, Alexis Falconieri, murió en esta fecha de 1310.
