

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY —JUNE 4TH, 2023
GLORY TO THE FATHER, THE SON, AND THE HOLY SPIRIT;
TO GOD WHO IS, WHO WAS, AND WHO IS TO COME.



The context of today's focus on the mystery of the Holy Trinity, the reading calls our attention to the action of God, who reveals himself in three persons: God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit. God the Father, out of love for the world, sent his Son into the world in order to save it. Through the death and resurrection of the Son, we have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit. As three persons, God acts always as a God of love; he does not condemn the world but acts to save it.

The Gospel also calls attention to the response that is required of us. God's love for us calls us to respond in faith by professing our belief in God's son, Jesus, and the salvation that he has won for us. This profession of faith is a sign of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

SOLEMNIDAD DE LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD - JUNIO 4, 2023 GLORIA AL PADRE Y AL HIJO Y AL ESPÍRITU SANTO. AL DIOS QUE ES, QUE ERA Y QUE VENDRÁ.

En el contexto del enfoque de hoy sobre el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad, la lectura llama nuestra atención sobre la acción de Dios, que se revela en tres personas: Dios Padre, Jesús Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Dios Padre, por amor al mundo, envió a su Hijo al mundo para salvarlo. A través de la muerte y resurrección del Hijo, se nos ha dado el don del Espíritu Santo. Como tres personas, Dios actúa siempre como un Dios de amor; no condena al mundo sino que actúa para salvarlo.


El Evangelio también llama la atención sobre la respuesta que se nos pide. El amor de Dios por nosotros nos llama a responder con fe profesando nuestra creencia en el hijo de Dios, Jesús, y en la salvación que él ha ganado para nosotros. Esta profesión de fe es un signo de la obra del Espíritu Santo en nuestras vidas.

WHY IS JUNE THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS?

June is known as the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus most simply because the solemnity of the Sacred Heart is celebrated during this month. This year, the solemnity falls on June 16. However, other reasons exist as to why June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart.

The feast dates back to 1673, when a French nun who belonged to the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary (Visitandines) in eastern France began to receive visions about the Sacred Heart. Jesus appeared to Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque and revealed ways to venerate his Sacred Heart and explained the immense love he has for humanity, appearing with his heart visible outside his chest, on fire, and surrounded by a crown of thorns

These different ways include partaking in a holy hour on Thursdays and the reception of the Eucharist on the first Friday of every month. Jesus told Sister Margaret Mary: "My Sacred Heart is so intense in its love for men, and for you in particular, that not being able to contain within it the flames of its ardent charity, they must be transmitted through all means."



On the current calendar, the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a solemnity, the highest-ranking feast in the liturgical calendar, although it is not a holy day of obligation.

This is a time of conversion, maturation, and quiet growth. It comprises the longest time on the liturgical calendar when the faithful consider the fullness of Je-

sus' teachings and miracles while on this earth. One symbol often found in Ordinary Time is comprised of two fish and a basket of bread — symbolizing Jesus' "Loaves and the Fishes" miracle.
