ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME- JUNE 18TH, 2023 "The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the Gospel"



In today's Gospel, Jesus shares his mission to proclaim the kingdom of heaven with his disciples. The signs of the kingdom's presence consist of the work that Jesus has already been doing: the sick are cured, lepers are cleansed, demons are driven out, and the dead are raised to life. The disciples are sent to continue doing the work that Jesus has begun.

This is a moment of transition in Matthew's Gospel. The focus has shifted from the ministry of Jesus to the work of the community that he has inaugurated. More than any other Gospel, Matthew's Gospel el aborates on the work of the Church, which is to continue after Jesus' death and resurrection.

Matthew lists the names of the twelve disciples, as do Mark and Luke. Matthew also uses the word apostle when referring to the Twelve. The word apostle means "one who is sent." In this context, Matthew is calling attention to the mission that the twelve disciples are being given. They are sent by Jesus to proclaim the kingdom of heaven in word and deed.

As Jesus sent his disciples to continue his work and mission, so too the Church is sent by Jesus. The Church is his continuing presence on earth. Every member of the Church is sent by Jesus to contribute to this mission.

XI DOMINGO ORDINARIO- JUNIO 18, 2023 El Reino de Dios está cerca, arrepiéntanse y crean en el Evangelio.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús comparte su misión de anunciar el reino de los cielos con sus discípulos. Los signos de la presencia del reino consisten en la obra que Jesús ya ha estado haciendo: los enfermos son curados, los leprosos son limpiados, los demonios son expulsados y los muertos son resucitados. Los discípulos son enviados a continuar haciendo la obra que Jesús ha comenzado.

Este es un momento de transición en el Evangelio de Mateo. El foco ha pasado del ministerio de Jesús al trabajo de la comunidad que él ha inaugurado. Más que cualquier otro Evangelio, el Evangelio de Mateo profundiza en la obra de la Iglesia, que debe continuar después de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús.

Mateo enumera los nombres de los doce discípulos, al igual que Marcos y Lucas. Mateo también usa la palabra apóstol cuando se refiere a los Doce. La palabra apóstol significa "uno que es enviado". En este contexto, Mateo está llamando la atención sobre la misión que se les está dando a los doce discípulos. Son enviados por Jesús para proclamar el reino de los cielos en palabra y obra.

Así como Jesús envió a sus discípulos a continuar su obra y misión, así también la Iglesia es enviada por Jesús. La Iglesia es su presencia continua en la tierra. Cada miembro de la Iglesia es enviado por Jesús para contribuir a esta misión.

3 EASY WAYS TO CELEBRATE FATHER'S DAY EVERY DAY

As Father's Day draws near, take a few moments to think about what it means for you, as a parent, to love your kids. Many parents get caught up in the whirlwind of after school activities, planning for fun-filled vacations, working hard to save for their future, and buying things that bring smiles to their faces.

While these actions spring from a heart filled with love, there are three very simple ways to love your kids that make a difference everyday:

1. Tell your kids you love them: Tell your kids you love them by actually saying the words—all the time. One of the ways kids learn best is through repetition. Saying "I love you" to them several times a day will help them know and trust that you really do love them.

2. Love your kids by listening to them: Turn off the TV, get off the computer, and spend at least ten meaningful minutes each day listening closely to your son or daughter. It's essential that kids be reminded of this amazing love on a daily basis. Knowing that they are beloved children of God will assure them that they not only have a special place in your family, they have an even more special place in God's family.

Introduce your children to God's love with these classic Bible verses for children. Keep on doing whatever those "big" things are that you do to show your kids you love them, but don't overlook the "little" things that show your love for them. After all, the little things ARE the big things.
