

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME— JULY 30TH, 2023

“ALL THINGS WORK FOR GOOD FOR THOSE WHO LOVE GOD”



In this week's Gospel, Jesus offers three more short parables:

The first two parables describe the great value of the kingdom of heaven. In the first parable, Jesus says that the kingdom of heaven is like a buried treasure that is worth possessing even if it means giving up everything else. In the second parable, Jesus proposes that the kingdom of heaven is like a pearl of great worth for which one will sell everything else to possess. These parables teach us that we are to place everything we value in the service of the pursuit of the Kingdom of God.

The third parable that Jesus proposes in today's Gospel is different from the first two, but it is reminiscent of the parable of the sower heard in last week's Gospel. The kingdom of heaven is compared to fishing with a wide net. After the fish have been collected, the good fish are kept and the bad fish are thrown away; so too, in the final judgment, will the wicked and the righteous be separated.

Today's Gospel concludes with a curious statement about the scribe who understands the kingdom of heaven. Here a metaphor is offered: this scribe is like the head of a household who "brings from his storeroom both the new and the old." The scribes referred to here are experts of Mosaic law. It is possible that Jesus is here instructing the early Christian community on how to proceed in the interpretation of Jewish law with respect to Jesus' "new" teaching. Jesus' teaching about the kingdom of heaven does not replace the Jewish tradition; it interprets it in a different light.

“TODO CONTRIBUYE PARA BIEN DE LOS QUE AMAN A DIOS”

En el Evangelio de esta semana, Jesús ofrece otras tres breves parabolas:

Las dos primeras parabolas describen el gran valor del reino de los cielos. En la primera parábola, Jesús dice que el reino de los cielos es como un tesoro escondido que vale la pena poseer aunque signifique renunciar a todo lo demás. En la segunda parábola, Jesús propone que el reino de los cielos es como una perla de gran valor por la cual se venderá todo lo demás para poseer. Estas parabolas nos enseñan que debemos poner todo lo que valoramos al servicio de la búsqueda del Reino de Dios.

La tercera parábola que propone Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy es diferente de las dos primeras, pero recuerda a la parábola del sembrador escuchada en el Evangelio de la semana pasada. El reino de los cielos se compara con pescar con una red. Una vez recogidos los peces, se guardan los buenos y se tiran los malos; así también, en el juicio final, los malvados y los justos serán separados.

El evangelio de hoy concluye con una curiosa afirmación sobre el escriba que entiende el reino de los cielos. Aquí se ofrece una metáfora: este escriba es como el cabeza de familia que “saca de su tesoro lo nuevo y lo viejo”. Los escribas a los que se hace referencia aquí son expertos en la ley mosaica. Es posible que Jesús esté instruyendo aquí a la comunidad cristiana primitiva sobre cómo proceder en la interpretación de la ley judía con respecto a la “nueva” enseñanza de Jesús. La enseñanza de Jesús sobre el reino de los cielos no reemplaza la tradición judía; lo interpreta bajo una luz diferente.



SAINT OF THE WEEK: AUG. 4TH SAINT JOHN VIANNEY

Saint John Vianney patron of priests, known as the "Curé of Ars". Born during the days of the French Revolution, was ordained a priest in 1815. Three years later he was made parish priest of Ars, a remote French Village, where his reputation as a confessor and director of souls made him known throughout the Christian world. His life was one of extreme mortification.

Great mystic manifested an imperturbable patience. He retained a childlike simplicity, and he remains to this day the living image of the priest after the heart of Christ. He heard confessions of people from all over the world for the sixteen hours each day. His life was filled with works of charity and love. It is recorded that even the staunchest of sinners were converted at his mere word. He died August 4, 1859, and was canonized May 31, 1925. I-Breviary

San Juan Vianney patrón de los sacerdotes, conocido como el "Cura de Ars". Nació durante los días de la Revolución Francesa, fue ordenado sacerdote en 1815. Tres años más tarde fue nombrado párroco de Ars, una remota villa francesa, donde su reputación como confesor y director de almas lo hizo conocido. en todo el mundo cristiano. Su vida fue de extrema mortificación.



Gran místico manifestó una paciencia imperturbable. Conservó una sencillez infantil, y sigue siendo hasta el día de hoy la imagen viva del sacerdote según el corazón de Cristo. Escuchó confesiones de personas de todo el mundo durante las diecisésis horas de cada día. Su vida estuvo llena de obras de caridad y amor. Está registrado que incluso los pecadores más acérrimos se convirtieron con su mera palabra. Murió el 4 de agosto de 1859 y fue canonizado el 31 de mayo de 1925.
