PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION -"C" APRIL 13TH 2025 "THE MASTER HAS NEED OF IT'

The passion account portrays Jesus offering mercy and compassion even as he endures His own suffering and death. At His arrest, Jesus' disciples turn to violence, one of them cutting off the ear of the high priest's servant. Jesus admonishes them to put away their weapons and heals the man's ear. At the start of His own passion, Jesus offers God's healing to one who is an instrument of His suffering. As He is raised upon the cross, Jesus begs God to forgive those who are crucifying Him. Unlike Mark and Matthew, Luke narrates that one of the criminals crucified with Jesus acknowledges his own guilt and somehow recognizes Jesus as a

prophet of divine mercy. Jesus responds to him: "today you will be with me in Paradise" (Lk 23:43).

The centurion's statement that "This man was innocent "(Lk 23:47) returns to the theme of the suffering righteous (or innocent) one of Isaiah. Even in death, God's saving power is at work, and Jesus, God's obedient servant, is acknowledged innocent as He awaits God's ultimate vindication.

DOMINGO DE RAMOS DE LA PASIÓN DEL SEÑOR ABRIL 13TH 2025 **EL SEÑOR LO NECESITA**

El relato de la pasion retrata a Jesu s ofreciendo misericordia y compasion incluso mientras soporta su propio sufrimiento y muerte. En su arresto, los discípulos de Jesus recurren a la violencia, uno de ellos le corta la oreja al siervo del sumo sacerdote. Jesus les



advierte que guarden sus armas y cura la oreja del hombre. Al comienzo de su propia pasion, Jesus ofrece la curacion de Dios a quien es instrumento de su sufrimiento. Al ser resucitado en la cruz, Jesus le ruega a Dios que perdone a quienes lo estan crucificando. A diferencia de Marcos y Mateo, Lucas narra que uno de los criminales crucificados con Jesus reconoce su propia culpa y de alguna manera reconoce a Jesus como profeta de la misericordia divina. Jesus le responde: "Hoy estaras conmigo en el Paraíso" (Lc 23,43).

La afirmacion del centurion de que "Este hombre era inocente" (Lc 23,47) vuelve al tema del justo sufriente (o inocente) de Isaías. Incluso en la muerte, el poder salvador de Dios esta obrando, y Jesus, el siervo obediente de Dios, es reconocido inocente mientras espera la vindicación final de Dios.

SERVING THE COMMUNITY THROUGH MANNA MINISTRY

In the Bible, "manna" refers to the miraculous food God provided to the Israelites during their 40-year journey through the desert, described as tasting like wafers made with honey and appearing with the dew every morning. In the New Testament, Jesus refers to himself as the "true bread from heaven," and manna is sometimes seen as a symbol of Jesus and the Eucharist.

Manna Ministry at Our Lady of Mount Carmel began in early 2009. Joni Zabala was OLMC's Manna

coordinator, shopping at the Food Bank weekly & creating the distribution list. Each Saturday morning a team was assigned to bag & distribute the bags of food to Rippling River & the Cachagua Community Park to serve those in need. Over the next 11 years the bags expanded to include fresh produce, meat, & dairy, when available, bread & non-perishable items. The cost of food provided was paid for by collections & donations from OLMC parishioners & purchased through the Monterey Food Bank.

Manna took a pause in 2020 due to COVID. In 2021, Janice & Jeff Hawkins restarted & expanded Manna Ministry. It was decided that those folks at Rippling River were receiving these benefits through many organizations, so

OLMC's focus was to serve those in Cachagua twice a month, with 3 teams rotating once every 6 weeks to bag & deliver. When Janice & Jeff left the parish, Alondra Valdez-Klemek took over management of the ministry.

The Manna Ministry delivers food bags on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month. This regular schedule provides stability and reliability for those we serve, enabling them to plan their meals accordingly.

The Manna Ministry has significantly impacted the area over the past 12 years. By providing essential nourishment, we have helped alleviate hunger and improve the overall well-being of countless individuals. Our efforts have fostered a sense of community and support, demonstrating the power of collective action rooted in compassion.

Volunteering with the Manna Ministry is a rewarding experience that offers the opportunity to make a tangible difference in the lives of others. Our volunteers come from diverse backgrounds, united by a common goal of serving those in need. The sense of fulfillment and camaraderie among our team members is invaluable, creating a supportive and uplifting environment.
